

VR-Member-HowTo Add VR to Android Home Page

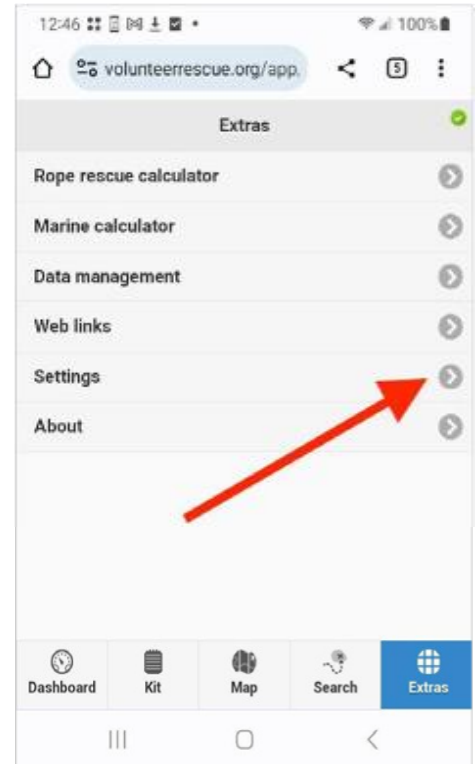
Newer Android phones running newer versions of Android OS, now access the VolunteerRescue app by using a web browser, such as Chrome.

This is different from accessing the VR website.

Enter <https://volunteerrescue.org/app> into a web browser.

“/app” is the important part.

- Tap **Extras** to configure access to the Yavapai County database.
- On **Extras** page, far right image, tap the **Settings** arrow.

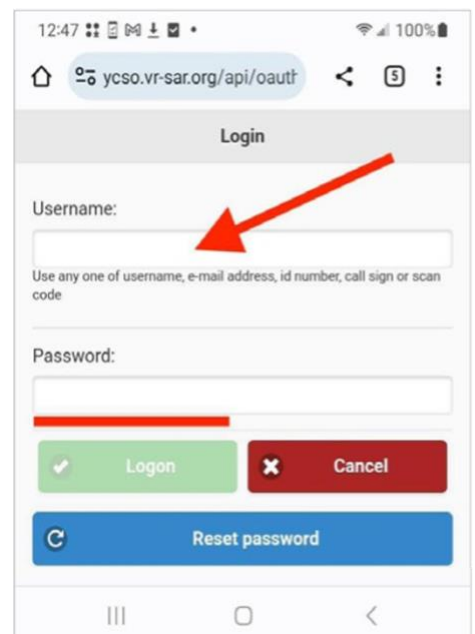
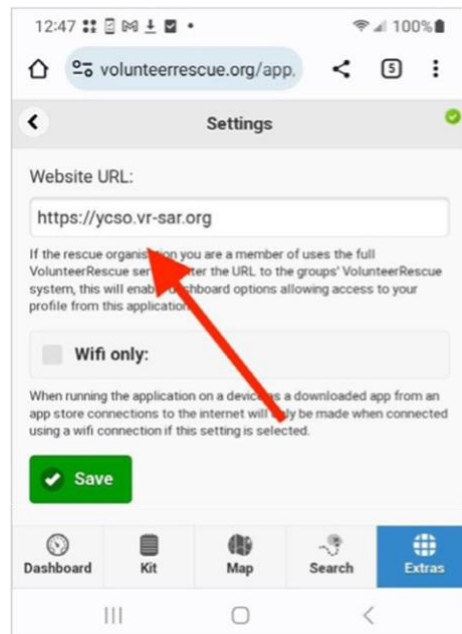


- On **Settings** page, enter <https://ycso.vr-sar.org> in Website URL.

To access the system in the field, **Wifi only must be unchecked.**

- Tap **Save**.
- On the **Login** page, far right, enter your username and password.

Note: Any one of the following can be used to log in: username, email address, 4-digit radio number.

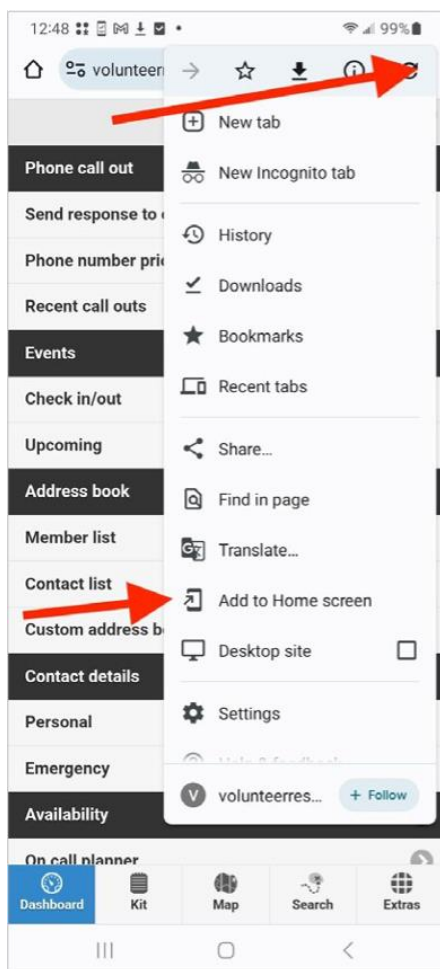


Once you have successfully logged in, the options list opens. Most used functions are **Send response to a callout** and **Events Check in/out**.

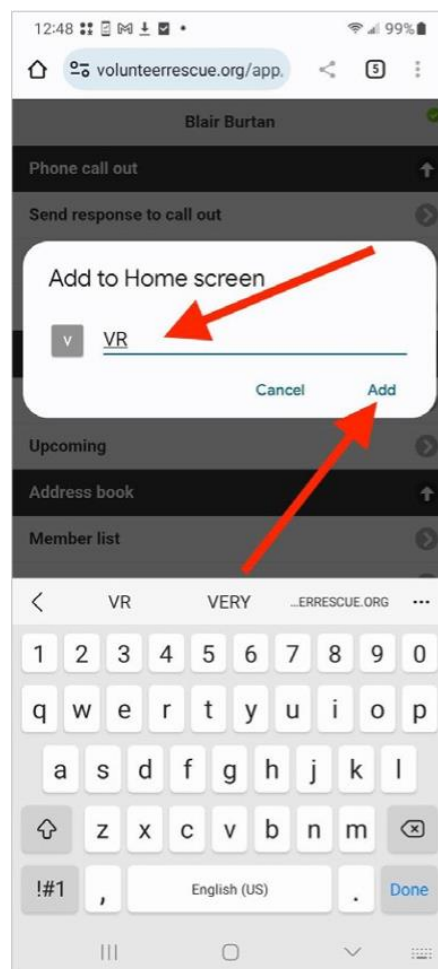
Add an icon to the phone's home screen to access VR quickly.

- Tap the **three vertical dots** to the right of the web address bar.

- Tap **Add to Home screen** from the drop-down menu.



- Enter 'VR' in the dialog box.
- Tap **Add**.
