- Arizona SAR II Continued Training Record (every time items 8,9,10 or 11 are updated, prior to submission of form to YCSO)
- Yearly equipment and 24-hour pack check forms
- Any additional certifications that are not documented in VR (BBP is automatically documented when completed online)
- Mission Rosters One person from the Jeep Posse needs to scan and forward a copy of the completed roster from a call out.

All documentation should be scanned utilizing the Genius Scan app and forwarded as PDF file with a small or medium file size. Each document should be scanned separately (multi-page documents can be one PDF file), and attached to an email sent to Steve Reinhart and cc'ing Mark Langfelder and John Wilcox as well as Dee Dee Loll if applicable.
